Drawing & Painting Studio

9 weeks
Mondays, Oct 16 – Dec 11, 7:00 - 9:30 pm

Traditional Spoon Carving

4 weeks
Mondays, Nov 6 – 27, 7:00 - 9:30 pm
Learn about green woodworking, a centuries old Scandinavian craft, while creating a functionally lovely carved spoon. Basic carving grips, safety and instruction for tool maintenance will be covered. Finishing techniques and personal touches will be presented for you to complete your custom-made utensil. Participants will then have the basic knowledge to pursue the craft upon completion of this course. *Note: Materials fee of \$45, payable first day of class, will include carving kit purchase.*

Silver Clay Jewelry

3 weeks

Community Art & Activism


4 weeks (Grades 7 & up)
